Toronto Central LHIN Updates

1. Examples of the use of OCHPP data:

- 2016 census data: used to update reports and profiles at LHIN, sub-region, and neighbourhood levels (placemats are currently in progress)
- East Network priorities analysis and sub-region scorecard
- Priority sub-region projects
 - Projects designed and implemented to target MLAA indicators (ALC, readmissions, ED visits)
- Sub-region collaboratives

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2. Decision Support team at Toronto Central LHIN: comprised of Health Analytics, Business Intelligence, and Digital Health
 - Continue to work jointly with our Home and Community Care counterparts (Business Intelligence)
 - Over time, developing a better understanding of one another's data and resources
 - 3 main data perspectives: health service utilization, home and community, community data
 - Joint projects/analyses between Health Analytics and Business Intelligence:
 - Nursing clinics
 - Readmissions
 - Reporting (ex. Operational Board Report)
 - 21 day wait time indicator
 - East Network
